

## Financial support for SENSE Course Development

SENSE strongly encourages its member institutes to collaborate and develop new PhD courses offered to the SENSE PhD students. To support the development of new courses and the collaboration between members, SENSE has allocated an annual fund of 20.000 euros for the next five years to support course development. If funds are not depleted in one year, they will be transferred to the next year. An overview of the existing courses can be found [here](http://www.sense.nl/courses) (<http://www.sense.nl/courses>). Applications are open to all SENSE member institutes.

Each proposal can apply for a maximum of 4.500 euro. This can be allocated to cover the costs of developing the course (this includes personnel costs). Applicants are expected to contribute teaching hours in-kind. Applicants may charge a fee for the course, but this can only be used to cover costs of accommodation and materials.

### Proposal requirements

Submissions for funding need to meet the following requirements:

- Courses will need to be developed by members of at least two different SENSE member institutes;
- Courses need to run for at least two consecutive periods;
- Courses need to be open to all SENSE PhD students;
- Opening the course to an international audience is encouraged.

### Submission and Review Process

Proposals for funding can be submitted throughout the year as long as there is budget available. Proposals will be reviewed bi-annually (May 31<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>). The proposals will be reviewed by the review committee consisting of the SENSE Directorate (Prof. Philipp Pattberg, Johan Feenstra and Daniel Petrovics), the chair of the SENSE Education Committee (Dr. Peter Vermeulen) and Dr. Kate Negacz.

Proposals need to show how they meet the requirements, include a budget overview explaining the allocation of the funds, and provide an outline of the course detailing the course content and the role of the involved SENSE members.

### Schedule

A budget of 10.000 euros will be made available bi-annually starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. This funding programme runs until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026. The bi-annual application deadlines are on May 31<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>. The review committee will announce the funded proposals no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>.
